What an interesting topic! Finding material will be a bit tricky, so what you'll need to do is be persistent and think carefully about keywords. I recommend keeping a list of what you've tried and where. Below are some places that I recommend looking:

Getting started, I did a really basic search in the Library's search tool, SearchPlus (just type into the large search box at lib.msu.edu) and just tried netherlands homosexual muslim immigrants as my keywords. It's a mix but some of the books and articles might be useful. For example, there's a chapter on the Netherlands in the book Guide to Islamist Movements: http://p2047-ezproxy.msu.edu.proxy2.cl.msu.edu/login?url=https://search-ebscobhost-com.proxy2.cl.msu.edu/login.aspx?direct=true&db=e00xna&AN=316402&scope=site&ebv=EB&ppid=pp_v2_479

Take a look at this and see turns up. You may want to use the filters on the left to limit date so that you don't end up with really outdated material.

Islam, Muslim
